**“New Leadership, New Ideas” – Sylvia Bishop and Team Delta
unveil 2018 election-campaign slogan**

August 1, 2018 – Delta, B.C. – Mayoral candidate Sylvia Bishop and her four-member Team Delta slate today introduced “New Leadership, New Ideas” as their 2018 election-campaign slogan.

“It seems certain that Delta’s City Council will have a significant number of new faces after the local-government elections on October 20,” said Bishop.

“One major change will occur in the Mayor’s office as Lois Jackson has announced her retirement after nearly 20 years of service, and three councillors elected in 2014 – Heather King, Ian Paton and I – will not be seeking re-election to council.

“Given the potential this fall for a considerable transformation of Delta council, Team Delta and I believe it is appropriate and necessary to clearly lay out our plans and aspirations for the future – and the phrase ‘New Leadership, New Ideas’ accurately describes the focus of our campaign.”

The Team Delta candidates seeking election to the city council include veteran Robert Campbell, and newcomers Joan Hansen, Kim Kendall and Simran Walia.

“As a long-time Delta councillor it seems evident to me that the 2018 elections represent in many ways a fresh start for our local government,” said Campbell.

“All of us, Mayor Jackson and the elected councillors working together, have accomplished a great deal over the last 19 years, and a solid foundation has been built for the future development of our community. To that end, I believe Sylvia Bishop and the Team Delta candidates have the vision, the passion and the determination to make our great city even better.”
